Letter from the CEO

Dear Respected Donor,

Thank you for making 2021 a remarkably successful year. Despite our unprecedented times, you have stepped up and given more in a time when there is less. Your generous spirit is a testament to what is possible when we work together.

Since the COVID-19 outbreak struck the world early in 2020, our staff has worked tirelessly and efficiently to continue distributing essential COVID-19 aid to families and individuals worldwide. This year, LIFE distributed over \$10 million worth of health programs and medical supplies/equipment; a large portion of this was distributed to prevent and control the spread of COVID-19. This assistance was directed toward fourteen countries' poor, needy, and underserved hospitals and clinics.

Other medical support given by LIFE includes an ambulance in Bangladesh, six hearing aid humanitarian trips in the USA, and furnished sensory rooms in centers for children with disabilities and down's syndrome in Pakistan and the West Bank.

Through another challenging year in our history, we continued to serve humanity by supporting over 8,000 orphans in eleven countries, giving them an opportunity for a better life. We also distributed food baskets to over 128,989 poor and needy families and fed hot iftar meals to 20,726 people in need. We supplied over \$5 million in in-kind shipments of school and dorm room furniture, food, and medical aid. We dug 206 water wells in thirteen countries and constructed a community center in Senegal.

We thank you so much for making a difference in the lives of many people struggling to survive during the pandemic these past few years, and we look forward to your continued support of LIFE's programs in 2022.

About Life


Mission Statement

Due to the great generosity of donors, Life has been able to distribute over \$548.4 million in humanitarian assistance items around the world, and in the process, kindly touched millions of lives.

Emergency Response

Life provides emergency relief to those in need in response to areas suffering from natural or man-made disasters by providing forms of shelter, food, water, bedding, blankets, household items, hygiene kits and emergency medical care.

LIFE provided nearly \$168,500 in emergency humanitarian relief to people affected by flooding in Afghanistan, Senegal, Mali, and Detroit, Michigan. Emergency earthquake relief in Haiti and Indonesia.

Health Programs

Life distributed \$10,052,948 in health programs and medical supplies/equipment distributions which includes ventilation devices for COVID – 19, an ambulance for use in Bangladesh, six hearing aid humanitarian trips in the USA, furnished sensory rooms in centers for children with disabilities and Down's Syndrome in Pakistan and the West Bank and provided health and COVID - 19 assistance to the poor and needy and underserved hospitals and clinics in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Iraq, Ghana, Lebanon, Mali, Pakistan, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Sri Lanka, Somalia, Syria, the West Bank and Gaza.

Education Programs

Life promotes literacy through the distribution of books to colleges, universities, primary and secondary schools, donates classroom furniture to schools in the United States of America and needy schools throughout the world and gives orphans and poor children uniforms, shoes and school bags filled with stationary, pens and other educational items through its back-to-school programs, and participated in providing food for students in primary and secondary schools in Africa.

In the education sector Life expended \$853,425 in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bosnia, the Dominican Republic, Haiti, Ghana, Iraq, Jordan, Kenya, Lebanon, Pakistan, Mali, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Sri Lanka, Syria, Yemen, and the USA.

Community Development

LIFE expended \$5,602,042 in community development through building community centers around the world where communities come together for social events and distribute furniture to people in need and those coming back into the community after incarceration and to families affected by natural disasters.

In 2021 LIFE assisted in community development by distributing furniture to needy families in the USA and by constructing a community center in Senegal.

Orphan Sponsorship/Family Assistance

Orphans Sponsorship

Life's orphan sponsorship program provides food, shelter, education and healthcare to orphans all over the world.

Life provided over \$2.7 million in Orphan Sponsorship to over 8,000 orphans in the following countries: Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Ghana, Haiti, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Mali, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Syria, the West Bank and Gaza.

An orphan's holiday party for Eid-Al-Fitr was held in Syria. Children received new clothing and toys for the celebration.

Family Assistance

Life distributed firewood for heating, winter blankets, coats, jackets, mittens, and hats to needy families in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bosnia, Iraq, Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, USA and Yemen.

Twenty-four containers of food aid was shipped and distributed to needy families in Somalia, Djibouti and Sudan.

Water/Sanitation Programs

Life understands the urgent need for clean water supply for communities to have access to clean drinking water as well as clean water to support good hygiene, proper health and for livestock populations. Life constructed 206 water wells in Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Ethiopia, Ghana, Iraq, Kenya, Pakistan, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Sri Lanka, Sudan and Uganda.

Seasonal Projects

Food basket distributions (Ramadan)

During Ramadan, Life distributed food baskets to over 128,989 poor and needy families. The food baskets contained enough food items to feed a family of 5-7 people for the month of Ramadan. In addition to food baskets, Life also provided over 20,726 lftar meals to communities, while also distributing Eid holiday gifts to poor children and orphans. The Ramadan distributions took place in 25 countries.

Fresh meat distributions (Udhiya/Qurbani)

The Eid-Ul-Adha holiday is anticipated for many Muslim families around the world, as they wait for fresh meat. Many needy families cannot afford to buy meat during the year, so this is a time that they have to anticipate the donation of meat.

During Udhiyah/Qurbani, Life distributed fresh meat to 206,412 needy beneficiaries in 25 countries in 2021.

Thanksgiving distributions

Life distributed 300 turkeys and 300 food boxes to families in need in the Detroit area for and hosted a Thanksgiving dinner for refugees and the disabled.

Senior Citizens Christmas Party

Life hosted a Christmas party and luncheon for in a senior citizens center in Dearborn, Michigan.
